About the Institution

Established in the year 1994 Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji Government College Paonta Sahib has earned its name after Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh guru who sojourned here between 1685- 1689. It is believed that Guru Maharaj spent most of his time here meditating and experiencing spiritual bliss. He wrote many religious books here and then went to Anandpur Sahib to establish the Khalsa Panth. The Gurudwara houses a museum which contains antiques and weapons used by Guru Gobind Singh during his stay.

The college campus is spread over 16 acres of land in village Shubh Khera at a distance of 1.5 km from the bus stand. The college has got the biggest playground in the town. The spacious and fully air conditioned library is equipped with more than 12000 books and has digital accessibility through N-List, funded by UGC as college component under UGCINFONET Digital Library Consortium.

The campus is under CCTV surveillance and has Wi-Fi system for online connectivity. The college is affiliated to the Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), Shimla and recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India, New Delhi. The college provides undergraduate degree courses in BA/ BSc/ BCom; professional degree in BCA/ PGDCA and post graduate degree in English, Economics, Political Science, Hindi and Commerce. The institution has achieved B++ grading in its first NAAC accreditation cycle for its quality oriented approach and potential for growth in Academic session 2016-17. Infrastructure grants of 2.0 crores was sanctioned to the institution under RUSA for its academic excellence. Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India has accorded financial support of rupees 63 lakhs to 3 departments viz. Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology of this college under Star College Scheme. Recently, proposal from departments of Physics, Geography and Computer Science has been sent for fresh grant under Star College Scheme. The college was among one of the nine Utkrisht Colleges during academic session 2021-22 and received a grant of Rupees 1 crore for the session.

Ragging.

- Crime against Women.
- Alcohol, Smoking, Chewing Tobacco, Ghutka etc.
- Misconduct, Hooliganism.
- · Possession or use of fire arms or any lethal weapon.
- Possession or use of hallucinogenic drugs in the campus.
- · Posession or use of alocholic beverage of delinquency under the influence of alcohol.
- Use of cell phones other than specified zone in the campus.
- · Bringing of outsiders in the premises.

Students found accused of such act by the way of indulging in or outside the college premises shall be liable to punishment as per the guidelines given by UGC in the light of Hon'ble Superme Court Directions. The possible punishment shall be anyone or the combination of the following:-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Suspension/withdrawing of Scholarship and other financial benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in examination and other evaluation process.
- Debarring from represnting the institution in any intra-college/inter-college/inter-university/international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension and rustication from the college.
- · Cancellation of Admission.
- · Special Fine depending upon the gravity of the offence
- Collective Punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of Ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Note: The cases pertaining to the Ragging will be reported to the police and will be dealt as per Himachal Pradesh Education Institution (Prohibition of Ragging) Act 2009 according to which Ragging has been declared as a 'Cognizable and Non-Bailable Offence'. Any student convicted of Ragging related offence will be punished with the imprisonment of upto 3 years or fine of Rs.50,000 or both.

ADMISSION RULES & ELIGIBILTY CONDITIONS

The Minimum qualification prescribed for admission to the courses and examination leading to the degree course of the university shall be in accordance with the first ordinance of HP University 1973 (clause 1.4 Chapter-1) Any student who is seeking admission in the college in any Faculty / Course has to fulfill the following eligibility condition/Rules (clause 3.3A of Chapter IIII Vol.1) of the Ordinace of HP University.

Students seeking admission in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com 2nd & 3rd year will have to take roll -on admission without waiting for the previous result. However, their admissions shall be purely provisional and subject to the result of previous class.

A. Academic Qualification BA-I-(Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.A.-1 (Pass Course) the candidate should have passed:

B.Com-I (Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.com-I (pass course) the candidate should have passed:

(I) 10+2 examination (commerce stream) with minimum 40% are eligible for admission in 1st year of the course.

OR

(II) A student who has passed +2 or equivalent exams other than commerce stream in four written subjects (including English) with Economics or Mathematics as compulsory subject at +2 level with 45% marks is eligible for admission in 1st year of the course.

B.Sc.-I (Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.Sc.-I (pass course) the candidate should have passed:

(I) 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination (PCM/PCB) in science from a recognized Board/University established by law in India with five subject (including Enlgish) with at least 45% marks.

(II) Intermediate examination of an Indian University / Board or any examination (PCM/PCB) recognized equivalent thereto (pass in four subjects, one language and three other elective subjects) with minimum 45% marks) is eligible for admission to B.Sc.-I. किसी मान्यता प्राप्त बोर्ड/विश्वविद्यालय से विज्ञान संकाय में (PCM/PCB) में किसी भाषा सहित चार विषयों में 45% न्यनतम कल अंकों के साथ इंटरमीडिएट या समकक्ष।

Remarks:-

While determining percentage of marks for eligibility, rounding off of traction of 0.5 or above to the next full unit is permissible. A relaxation of 5% is available to SC/ST candidates for admission to B.Sc./B.Com 1st year.

Important Note:-

At any stage, if any student is found to claim his/her basic eligibiltiy qualification from take or unrecognized Board/University, his/her admission shall stand automatically cancelled. The College shall not be responsible for cancellation such admissions.

B. Age Limit

For admission to the 1st year of any course a student must not be more than 23 years (25 years for girls) of age as on 1st July 2022 e.g. the applicant should not be born earlier than 01-07-1999 in case of boys and 01-07-1997 in case of girls. However, in r/o SC and ST Students, a relaxation of 3 years is given.

The Vice-Chancellor of HPU Shimla has the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum of 6 months. All such cases will be granted age relaxation provisionally upto six months by the Principal and a consolidated list of such cases will be sent for apporval of the Vice-Chanceller by 31st October of every Academic Year. A candidate who has availed age relaxation at the time of first admission shall be eligible for the same in the subsquent classes also.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for Undergraduate (UG) Courses: 2018-19 Academic Session

The Himachal Pradesh University Vide Letter No. 2-1/2022 fg-iz-fo('IS) dated 4 June 2016 has notified the acceptace of the latest course curriculum under Choice Based Credit system CBCS brought out by the University Grants Commision for implementation from the 2016-17 academic session. With effect from academic session 2018-19, the semester system in the under graduate classes has been replaced by the annual system without any change in the existing structure of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) under Rashtriya Ucchatar Shikasha Abhiyan (RUSA).

Basic Outline of Choice Based Credit System

 Core Courses (C): 12 courses for regular including 2 papers each for English and Hindi/MIL In B.A./B.Com.

2. Elective Course:

- 2.1 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course: 1 honours courses and 2 each for regular courses. Elective courses offered under the main discipline/Subject of Study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective.
- 2.2 Generic Elective (GE) Course: 4 for honours courses and 2 each for B.A./B.Com. Regular courses. An elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/Subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyound discipline/s of choice is called a Generic elective. A core course offered in a discipline/Subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred as Generic Elective.
- Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds:
- 3.1 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): AECC Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement; I. Environment Science and II. English/Hindi/Mil Communication. These are mandatory for all disciplines.
- 3.2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):
 These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value based and / or skill based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands-on/training/field work. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hands-on mode so as to increase their employability.
- Practical/Tutorials : One each with every core and discipline/generic specific elective paper.

Students Course Wise Assessment and Evaluation

All Courses involve an evaluation system of students that has following two components : सभी पाठ्यक्रम की एक निर्धारित मुल्यांकन पद्गति है जिसके निम्न दो भाग हैं।

(a) Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA)

Accounting for 30% of the final grade that the student gets in a course, and विद्यार्थियों द्वारा पाठयक्रम में अंतिम श्रेणी में प्राप्तांकों का 30 प्रतिशत तथा

(b) End Semester Examination

Accounting for the remaining 70% of the final grade that the student gets in a course. विद्यार्थी द्वारा चुने गए पाठ्यक्रम में अंतिम श्रेणी में शेष प्राप्तांक का 70 प्रतिशत।

Note: A student will have to pass both the components (i.e. CCA and ESE) separately with 40% marks each to become eligible to be declared successful in a course.

 Mid-Term Test will be conducted by the college
- b. Seminar/Assignment (संगोष्ठी/सत्रीय कार्य) Maximum Marks -10 (अधिकतम अंक 10)
- Attendance Minimum requirement 75% (कक्षा उपस्थिति न्यूनतम सीमा 75 प्रतिशत)
 Maximum Marks -05 (अधिकतम अंक 5)

SCHOLARSHIPS

A Number of scholarships are available for the eligibile and deserving students. Information regarding dates, eligibility conditions and procedure for applying for these scholarships will be notified on the college notice board from time to time. The students may apply online for these scholarships.

State Sponsored Scholarship Schemes

- IRDP Scholarship Scheme: The students who belong to IRDP families may apply for these scholarships with required documents. A sum of Rs. 1200/- per annum is provided as financial assistance.
- Financial Assistance to the children of the armed Forces Personnel Killed/ disabled during the different War/ Operations: Children of armed force personnel killed/disabled in the different wars/ operations are eligible for the assistance. Application proformas are available with district Sainik Welfare Board. A sum of Rs. 1200/- per annum is provided as financial assistance.
- 3. Indria Gandhi UtkrishtChhatravritti Yojna for post plus two students:

The Indira Gandhi UtkrishtChhatravritti Yojna for meritiorious students for the post plus two courses shall be awarded to 150 students @ Rs. 10,000/- p.a. per students purely on the basis of the merit and without any income ceiling. The Scholarship will also be awarded to ten toppers each from the merit list of 10+2 Arts, Science and Commerce, supplied by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala, provided they join any academic/ professional stream. The scholarship will be renewed every year to the same number of students till they complete degree/ course.

4. Kalpana Chawla Chhatravriti Yojna:

This is a state sponsored scheme started from the year 2012-13. Under the scheme the top 2000 meritorious girl students of 10+2 of all study groups i.e. Science, Arts and Commerce streams are awarded a scholarship of Rs. 15000/- per students per annum based on passing ratio in each group as per the merit list supplied by HP Board of School Education, Dharamshala. The scholarship will be renewed till the completion of Degree/Diploma/Certificate Course provided there is no failure.

Centrally Sponsored Scholarship Schemes

- Post- Matriculation Scholarship for SC students: For students belongings to SC category whose parents, annual income does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-
- Post -Marric Scholarship scheme for ST students: For students belonging to ST category whose parents, guardian income from all sources does not exceed 2,00000/-
- Post- Matriculation Scholarship Scheme to OBC students: The students belongings to OBC category are entitled for this scholarship if the annual income of their parents is up to Rs. 1,00,000/-
- 8. Maharishi Balmiki Chattarvritti Yojna: The scholarship under this scheme is @ Rs. 9000/- per year given to the Bonafide Himachali Girls Students belonging to Balmiki Families, engaged in unclean occupation. The concerned students must apply on prescribed proforma through their head of the school/ college/ Instutution along with balmiki certificate.
- Merit- Cum means Scholarship for Students belonging to the Minority Community (Centrally Sponsored Scheme): The annual income of the parents/ guardians of the beneficiaries should not exceed Rs. 2.5 Lakhs from all source and the students should note have secured less than 55% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- 10. Post- Matric Scholarship scheme for Students belonging to Minority (Centrally Sponsored Scheme): The annual income of the parents/ Guardians of the beneficiaries should not exceed Rs. 2 Lakh from all sources and the students should not have secured less than 50% marks or equivalents grade in the previous final examination. The students must have passed the examination from government/ Government- Aided institutions.

- 11. Post matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities: This scheme is available to students with disabilities who are covered under the person with disabilities (Equal opportunity, protection of rights and full participation) Act, 1995. Scholarship under the scheme will be awarded by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, Government of India. Scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/Guardian's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- per annum.
- 12. Scholarship for Children of Mine Workers: The scheme is sponsored by the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India. Either of the Parents of the students should be a beedi worker or a mine worker (Iron Ore/ Manganese Ore/ Chrome Ore Mines, Limestone/ Dolomite or Mica or a cine worker) for six months at least, this would also include contract laborers. Total income of both the parents of the students from all sources should not exceed 10,000 p.m. including all allowance. The scholarship under this scheme is Rs. 3000/- per year.
- 13. Dr. Ambedkar Post Matric Scholarship: This scheme is for Economically Backward Class(EBC) students belonging to General category and total income of parents/guardian shall not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum

Individual-Sponsored Scholarship

Chaudhary Sher Jung Memorial Scholarship: This Scholarship of Rs. 2000/- per students (one girl and one boy students) from each faculty of Arts, Commerce and Science is given to meritorious student coming from economically weaker families to encourage them.

Fee Concession

Half Fee Concession: One of the two or more real brother/sister studying in the lower class in the college will be eligible for 50% exemption in tuition fee.

Code of Conduct for Students

 $Students\,should\,follow\,the\,rules\,and\,regulations\,laid\,down\,by\,the\,college\,administration.$

- The Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Act, 2009 will be followed in letter
 and spirit. Indulging in Ragging is a crime and strictly prohibited by an act promulgated by the Government of
 H.P with the maximum penalty of Rs.50000/- and imprisonment up to three years or both.
- If any student indulges in any form Eve Teasing inside the college premises or outside, he/she will be dealt as per law.
- 3. Every student should be dressed up properly.
- 4. Every student must always carry with him/her duly completed identity card which is issued to him/her at the time of admission. He/she must produce the identity card whenever demanded by Security guard, any Teacher or Principal of the college. In case of loss of Identity Card, a duplicate I-card after a payment of Rs20/ will be issued.
- Every student has to attend 75% of the classes of each subject/paper.75% of attendance is mandatory for appearing in the annual examination.
- In case a student is absent in a class continuously for six consecutive days or for 10 days in a month, his /her
 name will be struck off from the college rolls (In all subjects). Re-admission in such cases will be allowed

- within a week. For next seven days he/she has to deposit a fine of Rs.100/ for re-admission. After15 days from the date of struck off, re-admission will be allowed with the representation of the parents, recommendation of the concerned subject teacher and a fine of Rs.1000/
- Any student who is unable to appear in the scheduled house test can reappear for the same only on genuine grounds with prior Permission of the Principal.
- Any other eligible student can reappear for the House Test with recommendation of the concerned course teacher and permission of the Principal. A fine of Rs100/ per paper will be charged and students can reappear within 15 days after the completion of House Exam.
- 9. Students should not bring outsiders into the campus without the prior permission of the authorities.
- 10. Sale, distribution, use and possession of banned drugs, alcohol and tobacco products are strictly prohibited and in case of violation shall be dealt with as per law.
- 11. Fireworks, explosives, weapons, or items of destruction are prohibited in the college campus.
- Writing on classroom walls, desk, benches, door, toilet wall or pasting of posters on the wall are strictly banned.
- 13. For Intentional or deliberate damage caused to property (building, furniture, electrical wires/switches/ appliances and sanitary ware etc.), the recovery cost shall be the cost of replacement/repair. It may also be reported to the Police for action as per law.
- 14. Any damage to lab equipment / articles shall entail fine equal to the cost of equipment.
- Legal action will be initiated against those who destroy or cause to destroy the property of the college under existing laws including the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.
- Students should not create disturbance in the academic, administrative, sporting, social, cultural or other cocurricular activities of the College.
- 17. Any behavior falling in the category of sexual harassment at workplace should be reported to the Internal Complaints Committee of the college immediately and the matter would be dealt with as per the Law.
- 18. Any case of violation of law and order in the college campus will be reported to the police for initiating action against the offenders.
- 19.Use of Mobile Phone /internet, laptop, and tablet by students within the college campus is permitted at specified places for academic purposes only. Violation of rule will lead to fine of Rs.100/.
- 20. All other fines will be charged as notified by University from time to time.
- 21. Misconduct during examination, production of false information or documents for admission purpose and the failure to return materials issued from the college would be seriously dealt with.

- 22.Gathering in groups at roads, entrance, exit, pathways, corridors and in the administrative block is strictly prohibited. Students who have no class to attend during any particular period should not loiter in the corridors.
- All vehicles should be parked in the allotted area. Wrong parking reported by the security guard will be fined Rs.100/.
- 24. Students can file their genuine complaints to the concerned authority and drop it in the suggestion box placed in the administrative block.
- Students will appear in the Annual Practical Examination only on scheduled dates as notified by the University.

In general any kind of misconduct towards institute will not be tolerated and punished as per the gravity of the misconduct.

Ragging

"Ragging includes any type of physical or mental torture inflicted by any individual or group, either by words or conduct which creates an apprehension in the mind of the person that he/she cannot pursue his/her studies free from any mental disturbance or torture created thereby. Any person who aids or abet such an action shall also be guilty of such ragging.

Ragging in and around the college/hostel campus or on roads/ approaches leading there to is strictly prohibited. If any student is found indulging in ragging, directly or indirectly, the college authorities shall be obliged under rule 22, 17 (a), (b) & (c) of HP. University to expel the guilty student (s) from the college/hostel.

LIBRARY

The college has a spacious library which is well ventilated and well illuminated for readers and has more than 12000 books pertaining to various subjects. The college subscribes to various national & international journals of repute.

A. Rules and Regulation

Identity card and library card should be collected from the librarian as per the schedule notified by the librarian. A student must bring his/her library card to get the books issued in his/her name. Only two books are issued to a student at a time for a period of 14 days. Reference Books/Dictionaries/News Papers/Periodicals will not be issued.

If the issued books are not returned by due date, a fine at Rs. 1.00 per book per day will charged. In case of loss of book, the student will have to replace the book with new one or pay actual price of the book plus 20% of the original prices as a fine amount.

Books returned in damaged condition will entail penalty as per rules. Failure to return the book or to pay the penalty imposed will entail the same procedure for recovery as in the case of recovery of Govt. property i.e. through the police or Deputy Commissioner.

C. No Dues Certificate & Refund of Library Security

All the issued books must be returned and library card be surrendered to the librarian before the annual examination. A No Dues Certificate to this effect must be obtained from the librarian otherwise Admit Card for Annual Exam will not be issued.

Leave Rule

- 3. Leave for more than three days will be sanctioned by the Principal
- 4. The Students will be marked absent during the leave period and the same will not be considered for calculating the lectures attended by him/her for determining his/her eligibility to appear in the University Examination. However in case leave is properly sanctioned, neither his/her name will be struck off from the rolls, nor any absence fine will be imposed.

Keeping this in view we have societies like Science Society, Social Science Society, Red Ribbon Club and ECO Club etc. Students are encouraged to join these societies as per their interest. Students can approach the In-charge of these societies.

National Service Sechem (NSS)

The college has two NSS units. Enrollment in NSS is done in the beginning of the session in the month of August. Students have to apply as and when notified through notice board/college website for enrollment in NSS.

Rovers & Rangers

The College has got one unit of Rovers and Rangers each. Basically it is voluntary non-political youth organization wherein students are trained to combat during natural disaster and otherwise too. It helps its members to have all round developement and become perfect responsible individulas to the society, nation and the world at large.

Mentor Cell

The students are encouraged to interact with their teachers regarding their problems which may be academic, non-academic or personal. Appropriate help and guidance is provided to cater the needs of students. It is also an essential and integral part of IQAC.

College Students Central Association (CSCA)

The college student central association is formed every year as per the rules laid down by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time. Presently the selection for various post of this association is done through merit i.e. indirect selection mode.

Parent Teacher Association (PTA)

To encourage community participation in education, Parent Teacher Association (PTA) under section 2.33 to 2.33.7 of the HP Education Code, 2001 has been established. It is an non-political body for better co-ordination and interaction between parents and teachers for improvement of academic standards and infra-strucural facilities of the college.

IGNOU

IGNOU Study Centre-1133 G.C. Paonta Sahib is running various educational and vocational programmes. All IGNOU courses are recognised by the Govt. of India & by the UGC. The college students can simultaneously do any of the degree or diploma programmes from IGNOU. The additional professional courses under walk-in admission can be done throughout the year in July or January section. No migration and no age limit is required for IGNOU courses.

NCC

The NCC wing for girls has been introduced in the college from the session 2020-21 onwards. The aspiring girls students may contact Dr. Pooja Bhati, Officer of the Girls Unit.

GCP Alumni Association

The Alumni Association of Government College, Paonta Sahib was formed on 7th October, 2016 and named as "GOVERNMENT COLLEGE PAONTA SAHIB ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (GCPAA) PAONTA SAHIB". GCP Alumni Association is dedicated to bringing together the alumni community on a common platform to build another channel of personal and professional support to members through 'self-help' within the community. GCP Alumni Association membership can be obtained by paying a nominal registration and membership fee. The governing body of the association comprise of the following office bearers:

- President, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, Internal Auditor, Advisor are elected from amongst the alumni.

Self-Financing Courses

Other than routine traditional faculties of Science, Humanities, and Commerce the college has thrown open other important courses including BCA and PGDCA to cater to the needs of technological fast growing society. These self-financing courses are under control of the college level Higher Education Institute Society (Regd.). Presently 50 seats (25 subsidised & 25 Non-subsidised) are there in BCA and PGDCA each.

Star College Scheme

Star College Scheme was initiated in 2008 by Department of Biotechnology (DBT) to nurture excellence in undergarduate science education for holistic development of colleges. So far 96 colleges have been supported throughout the country under strengthening component. The emphasis of the scheme is on improving knowledge and skills of teachers, providing access to specialized infrastructure and consumables, to improve hands on training and industrial exposure as well as individual research projects for undergraduate students.

The DBT has accorded the financial support of rupees 63 lakhs for three years to three departments viz. Botany, Chemistry and Zoology of this college after screeing of the proposal and presentation before expert committee.

Objectives of Star College Scheme:

- * To strengthen the academic and physical infrastructure for achieving excellence in teaching and training.
- * To enhance the quality of the learning and teaching process to stimulate original thinking through 'hands-on' exposure to experimental work and participation in summer schools.
- * To promote networking and strengthen ties with neighboring institutions and other laboratories.
- * To conduct specialized training programmes for faculty improvement for optimizing technical

- capabilities.
- * To increase capabilities of core instrumentation resources by procuring new equipment and upgrading of existing facilities.
- * To provide access and exposure to students to research laboratories and industries in the country.
- * To help in devising standard curricular and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's)/ kits for practicals.
- To Provide better library facility to students and teachers.

The minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance test will be 35% to make the candidates eligible for interview/admission. In case of SC/ST candidates, the minimum qualifying marks shall be reduced until the full SC/ST quota for admission has been exhausted.

Important Instructions regarding filling up of online application(s) form(s):

- Applicant(s) are required to apply online through college official website i.e. www.gcp.ac.in. No other means/modes of application are acceptable.
- Applicant(s) must have a valid <u>Email ID</u> and <u>Mobile Number</u> before registering and creating login credentials.
- Applicant(s) must verify the email before logging in. It is a onetime process.
